ADMINISTRATION OF CREDIT: The College Board sends all scores to the Office of Testing and Evaluation. From there, they are sent to Transfer Credit Evaluation. The contact is Colleen McIlwain and can be reached at colleen@wayne.edu. The student is notified by email once the credit has been entered.

The College Board also sends copies of the score report to the student and the student's high school. Only official score reports sent directly to Wayne State are considered for credit. Credit is not awarded based on the credit awarded by another institution and placed on that institution's transcript. The student need only request the score be sent to Wayne State, the code is 1898. RESTRICTIONS: No more than 32 hours of AP credit or a combination of AP, IB, CLEP, and department-based credit by examination may be used toward a WSU degree, except by petition. All credit will be recorded on the student record.

**** LAB:** If a student satisfies both the areas of the Natural Science requirement (Life Science and Physical Science) by examination (AP, College-Level Examination Program (CLEP), or department based credit by examination), the University's Natural Science Laboratory requirement should be considered fulfilled (General Education Implementation committee, Compiled Requirements, Guidelines and Criteria. 5.23).
